

**When is the next AAC election?**

The next election will occur in June 2027 under the revised bylaws and two-year election cycle.

**How long are Board terms now?**

All elected Officers and Delegates serve two-year terms.

**Who can vote?**

Only Members of the AAC who are licensed Doctors of Chiropractic in Arizona and in good standing may vote.

**Do I need to attend convention to vote?**

No. Voting may occur through secure digital ballots, allowing members to participate remotely.

**Can someone vote on my behalf?**

No. Proxy voting is not permitted. Each member must cast their own ballot.

**How are nominations submitted?**

Members in good standing may nominate another qualified member or self-nominate when the call for nominations is issued.

**How long do members have to vote?**

Members have a 10-day voting window after ballots are distributed.

**How are ballots verified?**

Ballots must include the member's name and Arizona chiropractic license number to be valid. Ballots will be counted by the Ballot Counting Committee, which is comprised of the Director of Elections, two Board members, and one member of AAC administrative staff.

**When are election results announced?**

Results are announced within seven days after the ballots are validated and counted.
